3. Random camping by non-members is permitted in the Tribally managed portion of the Lake Roosevelt Management Area subject to payment of a designated fee only with a recreational vehicle (at 1310 and above elevation zones) or boat moored or anchored to the Reservation Zone of the Colville Confederated Tribes with self-contained sanitation facilities, and on the further condition that any garbage that is packed in is packed out.

**CAMPING FEES:**

All Camp Permits sold by a Natural Resource Enforcement Officer in the field will be charged double regardless of Campground or Random Camping. It is our intent to get the campers to utilize the outlets that sell the camping permits.

**CAMPGROUND FEES: (increase in fees )**

1 DAY PERMIT = **\$15.00**

3 DAY PERMITS = \$35.00  
7 DAY PERMITS = \$80.00  
SEASONAL PERMITS = \$350.00

Permit is good until noon of the last day of the permit. A campsite shall be limited to eight people, one tent, or one R.V. Any additional people, tents, or R.V.'s will require additional permits.

**RANDOM CAMPING FEES:**

(These fees are per boat or tent on Lake Roosevelt only)

1 DAY PERMIT = \$ 10.00  
3 DAY PERMITS = \$25.00  
7 DAY PERMITS = \$55.00  
SEASONAL PERMITS = \$200.00

**AREAS CLOSED EXCEPT TO FAMILY AND GUESTS OF TRIBAL MEMBERS:**

All land of the Tribes not listed in Section 2 (of the "Open Areas Subject To Fee & Permit) both within and outside the Reservation, are closed to camping by non-members of the Tribes, except as follows:

Family members of tribal members, as defined in Section 4-1-483 of Chapter 4-1 Fish, Wildlife and Recreation, may camp without a permit on all lands open to the tribal members, provided that an adult tribal member who is a family member be at all times physically present with such non-member(s), except that a non-member who is the legal guardian of a minor tribal member may camp with said minor tribal member.

(a) Non-member guests of tribal members may also camp without a permit on all lands open to tribal members, provided that an adult tribal member be at all time physically present with the guests, and provided further that there shall be not more than five (5) non-member guests in the company of one (1) tribal member (this does not include family members).
