POSITION: On-Call Registered Nurse
SALARY: \$16.90 per hour, less one step
REPORTS TO: Director of Nursing
LOCATION: Colville Tribal Convalescent Center, Nespelem, Washington

BASIC FUNCTIONS: Provide direct nursing care to the residents. Supervise the day-to-day nursing activities performed by NAC staff. Such supervision must be in accordance with all current federal, state, and local standards, guidelines, and regulations governing the facility. Provide the highest degree of care to each and every resident.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (Education and Training):

- Must possess a current license as an LPN or RN in the state of Washington.
- Must be able to read, write, and understand the English language.
- Must be knowledgeable of nursing, medical practices and procedures, as well as laws, regulations, and guidelines that pertain to long-term care.
- Must be able to work and think independently.
- Participate in resident assessment and care plan activities.
- Complete and file required record keeping forms, charts upon the resident admission, transfer, and/or discharge.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be able to push, move, and/or lift a minimum of 20 pounds to a minimum height of 3 feet and be able to push, pull, move, and/or carry such weight a minimum distant of 100 feet.

Note: This position has been identified as a "Safety Sensitive" position. Pursuant to CCT policies, this position is subject to pre-employment, post-accident, and random drug testing.
