LOCATION: Colville Tribal Convalescent Center, Nespelem, Washington

General: Provide direct nursing care the residents. Supervise the day-to-day nursing activities performed by the NAC's. Such supervision must be in accordance with all current federal, state, and local standards, guidelines, and regulations governing the facility. Provide the highest degree of care to each and every resident.

Qualifications:

- Must possess a current license as a LPN in the state of Washington.
- Must be able to read, write, and understand the English language.
- Must be knowledgeable of nursing, medical practices and procedures, as well as laws, regulations, and guidelines that pertain to long-term care.
- Must be able to work and think independently.

Special Requirements:

- Must be able to push, pull, move, and/or lift a minimum of 20 lbs for a distance of 100 feet.
