POSITION: Emergency Medical Technician, on-call

SALARY: \$11.70 per hour

REPORTS TO: District Supervisor/Lieutenant

LOCATION: Emergency Medical Services, Nespelem, Washington
Emergency Medical Services, Inchelium, Washington

BASIC FUNCTIONS: The incumbent in this position will respond to all emergency medical calls on the Colville Indian Reservation during shift, for the prevention of injury and the preservation of life and assets. Duties include: administer care to the critically ill and injured by controlling life threatening situations, assist to extent possible for initial attack and rescue operations, and perform search and rescue missions within the boundaries of the Colville Indian Reservation. This position may serve as Incident Command (IC) throughout an incident or until relieved. Responsibilities will also include acting as the technical representative for Colville Tribal Emergency Services (CTEMS) by providing over site and direction to outside responding agencies during emergencies for protection of assets within the Colville Indian Reservation. The incumbent will also respond to requests for fire, medical emergencies, and mutual aid. Additionally, the incumbent shall be required to attend all department training necessary to keep current with certifications and to support the goals and objectives of the program.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (Education and Training):

- High School Diploma or GED.
 - Must be at least 18 years of age.
 - Must possess a Washington State Emergency Medical Technician Certification and a CPR Card (**must provide a copy with application**)
 - Must be willing to obtain an NFPA (National Fire Protection Association) Fire Fighter I certification.
 - Previous patient care experience.
 - Experience working with indigenous people, preferred.
- **RECRUITING INDICATORS (Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities):**
- Must be of strong morale character, good temperament and stable lifestyle.
 - Knowledge of strong customer service skills.
 - Skills in the use of computers and associated software.
 - Ability to communicate both verbally and in written format.
 - Ability to make quick reasonable decisions in high stress situations.
- **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:**
- Must possess and maintain a valid State Driver's License and be eligible for the Tribes' vehicle insurance.
 - Must successfully clear an extensive Criminal History Background Inquiry.
 - Must be able to learn and enhance skill in fire suppression activities to respond to a structural fire.
 - Must be willing to work a flexible schedule including holidays, weekends, and overtime when required.
 - Must be in good physical condition and have the ability to lift and transfer 250 pounds, with assistance from partner, from the scene to a gurney and into an ambulance.
 - Must maintain a home telephone, cell phone, or pager for contact.

Note: This position has been identified as a "Safety Sensitive" position. Pursuant to the CCT Policies, this position is subject to pre-employment, post-accident, and random drug testing.

TRIBAL MEMBER AND INDIAN PREFERENCE WILL APPLY; PREFERENCE WILL ALSO BE GIVEN TO HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERANS WHO ARE MINIMALLY QUALIFIED WITHIN EACH INDIAN PREFERENCE CODE.
