POSITION: Lookout Relief/Maintenance Operator (Seasonal)
SALARY: \$10.10 hourly, less 5% during probation
REPORTS TO: Lead Dispatcher/Dispatcher
LOCATION: Mount Tolman Fire Complex, Keller, WA

BASIC FUNCTIONS: This is a journeyman level position that performs general fire lookout duties in a variety of weather conditions while the regular lookout staff is on their rotation for days off. Duties include fire watch, supply delivery, water delivery, disposal, and to perform minor maintenance of fire lookout facilities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (Education and Training):

- Must have a high school diploma or GED to qualify for these positions.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver's License and be eligible for the Tribe's vehicle insurance.
- Ability to use pumper truck to deliver water and supplies to fire lookouts.
- Must satisfactorily pass a drug screening.
- Knowledge in the use and care of the Osborne Fire Finder.
- Working knowledge of the Colville Reservation and important landmarks to assist in identifying fire locations
- Knowledge in the maintenance of various types of lookout appliances such as heater, ranges, and refrigerators.
- Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.
- Working knowledge of portable radio to report smoke, location, and other problems to dispatcher.
- Ability to maintain daily log of activities and weather readings taken as required by the dispatcher.

NOTE: This position has been identified as a "Safety Sensitive" position. Pursuant to CCT policies, this position is subject to pre-employment, post accident, and random drug testing.

TRIBAL MEMBER AND INDIAN PREFERENCE WILL APPLY; PREFERENCE WILL ALSO BE GIVEN TO HONORABLY DISCHARGED VETERANS WHO ARE MINIMALLY QUALIFIED WITHIN EACH INDIAN PREFERENCE CODE.
