The **Education Review Board**, made up of representatives of the four reservation districts, Inchelium, Keller, Omak, and Nespelem, a teacher/education guidance counselor, and a student representative will select qualified candidates.

- 1. Cecelia Somday Education Fund application;
- 2. **Two** completed Cecelia Somday Education Fund Recommendation forms;
- 3. One-page essay (200 words maximum); and
- 4. Current high school and/or college transcript that <u>must include the past three terms</u>; Note: The Education staff is not responsible for attaching transcripts for current students.

An application and two recommendation forms are attached. Yearly applications are required.
