The Colville Tribal Emergency Operations Center has confirmed through the Colville Service Unit and Okanogan County Public Health three new positive cases of COVID-19 on the Colville Indian Reservation in the Nespelem district, today.

To date, the EOC has confirmed:

- 12 positive cases
- 7 remain in isolation
- 3 have been released from isolation by medical professionals
- 2 moved out of the area

Please continue to stay home and stay safe.

We know COVID-19 is in our communities and it is now as important as ever to follow social distancing guidelines.

- Stay home, stay safe.
- Practice social distancing by keeping a distance of about six feet from others if you must go out in public for essential activities.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.
 - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
 - Stay home if you are sick, except to get medical care.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when coughing or sneezing; throw used tissues in the trash.
 - Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.
