Older adults, take steps to reduce your risk of getting sick

Older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions like heart or lung disease or diabetes seem to be at higher risk for developing more serious complications from COVID-19 illness.

There are things you can do to reduce your risk of getting sick.

- Keep space between yourself and others (stay 6 feet away, which is about two arm lengths).
- Wash your hands often.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue or the inside of your elbow. Then wash your hands.
- Take precautions as you go about your daily life and attend events.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and things you touch often.

Know the symptoms of COVID-19

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty

breathing • Fatigue

- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea

People may also be asymptomatic, meaning they have COVID-19 but do not show symptoms.
