Reservation clinics continue testing for COVID-19, to date clinics have tested nearly 2,800

In all four district, Colville Service Unit clinics and Lake Roosevelt Community Health Center clinics continue to test for COVID-19. To date, the clinics have run just under 2,800 tests.

There are two reasons to test: First, if you have been in direct contact (within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes, unmasked), and second, if you have symptoms associated with the virus. In addition all four clinics do offer RANDOM testing, this is being done so we can determine if we have any asymptomatic cases in our communities.

Symptoms

People with COVID-19 experience a wide range of symptoms, from mild fatigue to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People experiencing the following symptoms may have COVID-19 and should consult a medical provider: Fever or chills

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
