## With Labor Day upcoming, please continue to practice social distancing and other measures

To date, the residents of the Colville Reservation have done very well minimizing the spread of COVID-19 locally.

However, over the summer we saw a trend of having spikes after long weekends. For this upcoming Labor Day Weekend, please continue to follow social distancing guidelines:

- Wear a mask in public places
- Practice physical distancing by keeping 6 feet between yourself and others
- Wash your hands often.
- Clean and disinfect daily.
- Cover coughs and sneezes with a tissue
- Do not touch your face unless you have washed your hands

## The Colville Reservation remains closed

The Colville Business Council announced, July 9, an extension of public safety measures aimed at slowing the spread of COVID-19 on the Colville Indian Reservation. These measures include:

- **The closure of the Colville Reservation to non-essential visitors, through December 31. All outdoor recreation activities such as camping, fishing, hunting and hiking are permitted only for tribal members and their immediate families who are all residents of the Colville Reservation.**
- **The prohibition of public gatherings or camping in groups of 10 or more people through September 30.**
- **The stay at home order for residents of the Colville Reservation through September 30.**
- **The prohibition of non-essential business activity on the Colville Reservation through September 30**
